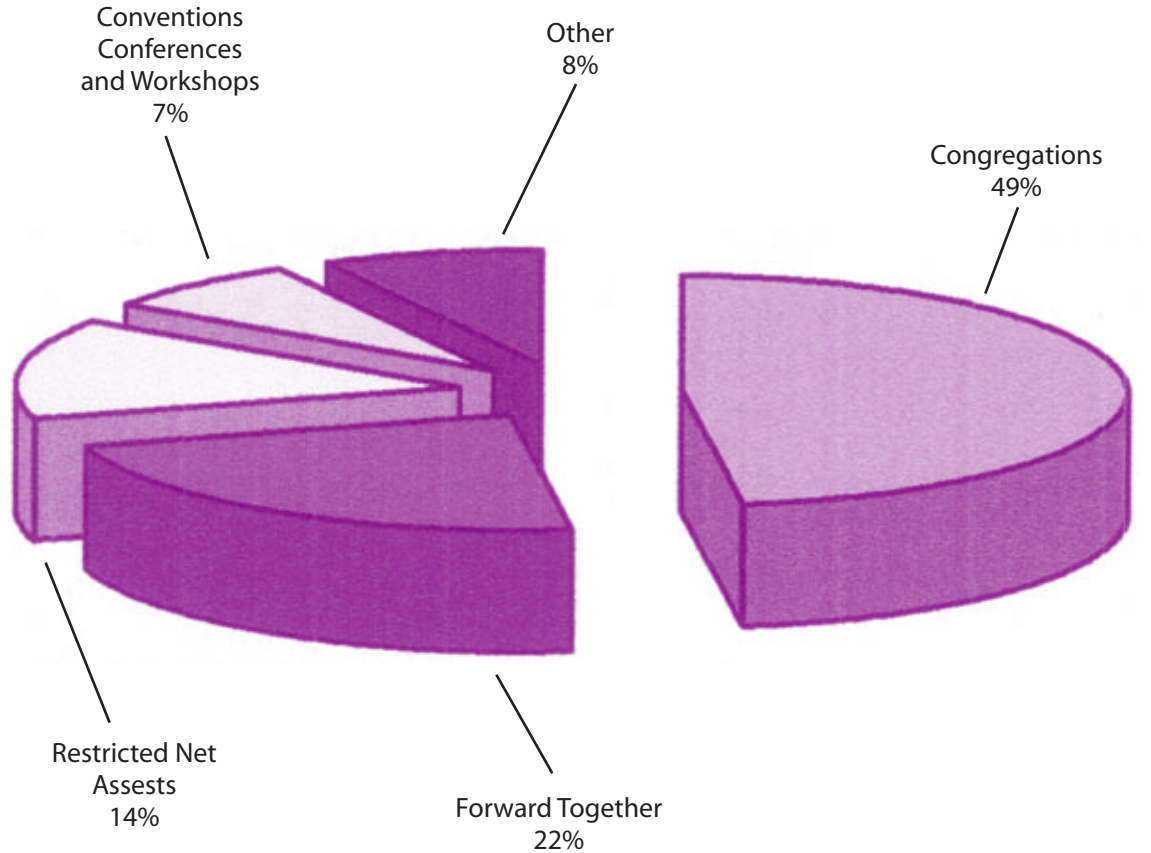

**District to Meet  
in Convention  
June 9-11**

Plans are being finalized for the 29<sup>th</sup> Florida-Georgia District Convention, set for June 9-11 at the Marriott Hotel in Lake Mary, FL. The theme for the three-day gathering is "Ablaze in the light of the Lord."

Packets including delegate credential and registration forms were sent to all District congregations in March.

In the cover memo accompanying that packet, Florida-Georgia District President Gerhard Michael Jr. said, "This will be a great opportunity for us to celebrate what God has enabled us to accomplish and to set our sights on the work He is setting before us."

Each District congregation may send one pastoral and one lay delegate to the Convention to vote on resolutions and elections. President Michael will appoint delegates to various floor committees to work on crafting resolutions. Those floor

committees are to meet Friday evening, April 28, and Saturday morning, April 29.

The Convention Workbook — including various reports and — is scheduled to be published this month. Workbooks will be sent to all delegates.

According to the tentative Convention schedule, floor committees will meet the morning of June 9, with the Convention to open at 7 p.m. The President's reception will follow.

Devotions, Bible study, elections and resolution votes will fill convention sessions. Updates will be presented on various educational, outreach and social ministry efforts. Special guests will bring greetings to the Convention.

A highlight of the Convention will be the presentation of Servant of Christ awards in recognition of dedicated service to the church. □
